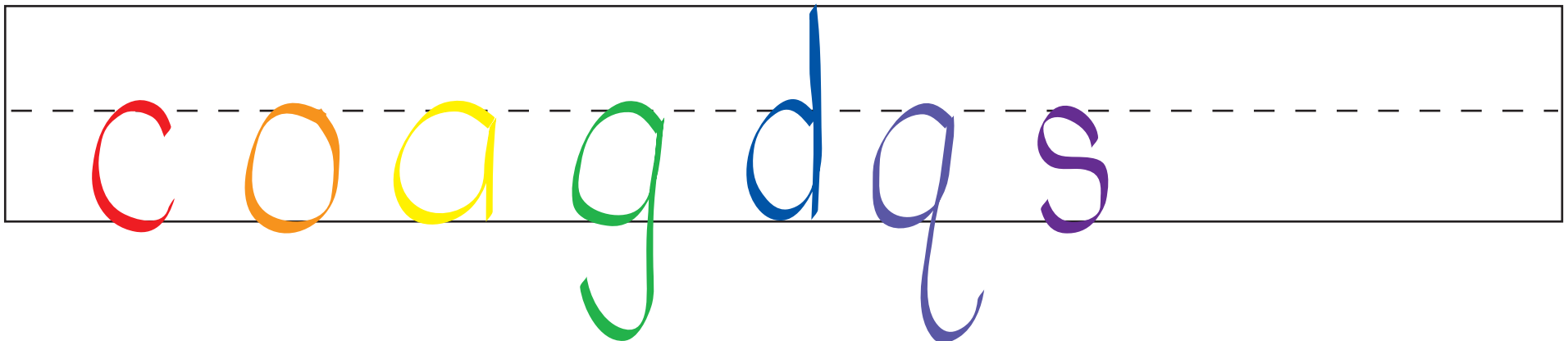
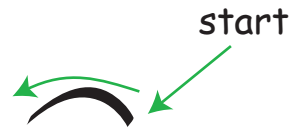

Rainbow Letters



Teach the children these "rainbow letters" for printing. Each letter starts with a rainbow arc and is continuous. The pencil is not picked up until the letter is completed.

Knowing how to form the letters makes most children's penmanship quickly look better.

It is crucial each of these letters is made in the correct direction, even the letter "o".

Calling these rainbow letters helps children remember the group and also helps them understand how to start the letter. I tell them that they start with a "rainbow arc".

My children are learning to read by the Wilson program. I have them record these rainbow letters in their notebook.
