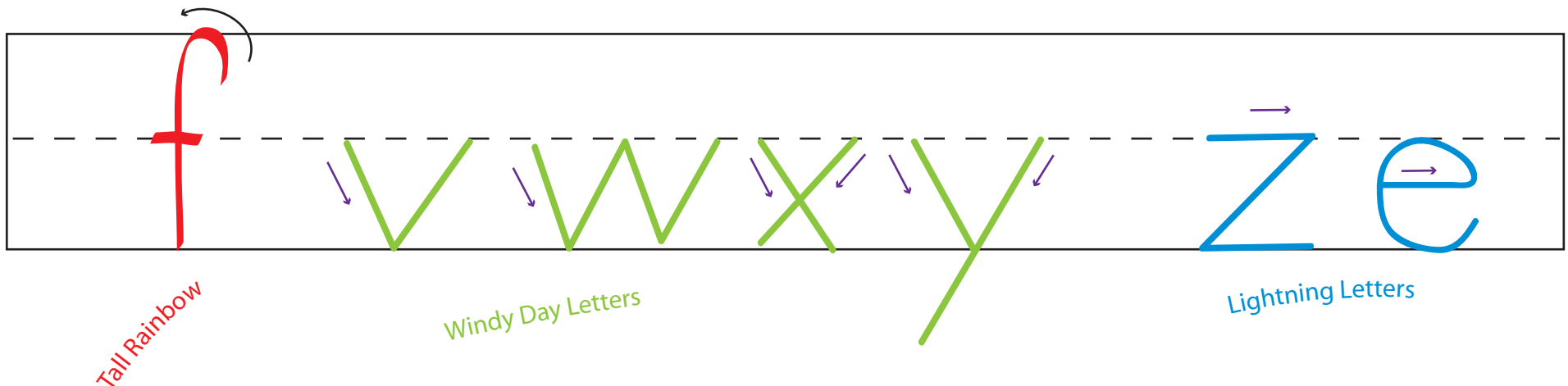

A Tall Rainbow Letter Windy Day Letters, Lightning Letters

There is one more Rainbow Letter. It's the "f" and the only tall rainbow. I remind children that Rainbow Letters start with an arc and go from right to left.

I call the v, w, x, and y "Windy Day Letters" because they start with a slant.

The z is a "Lightning Letter" and the e is a "Low-to-the-Ground Lightning Letter".

If you are a parent or teacher of a child with a learning disability, the time that you must spend in teaching a child to print the letters correctly is not wasted. Where another child might learn it in one sitting, your child might need many, many chances to practice. Or sometimes in one sitting, your child might need up to ten practices with the same letter before he/she can, for example, remember to start the f at the top, instead of the bottom line. But with kind persistence your child will learn.
